Security for Your Business is a practical planning session for business owners and leaders who want to move beyond basic security measures and build a plan that functions when something goes wrong. The session covers five areas: identifying what your organization is actually protecting, using a risk framework to decide where to act first, understanding how physical security works in layers, connecting physical and cyber security so neither operates in isolation, and building the procedural foundation that keeps security from existing only on paper. No technical background is required. The content is built for decision-makers who want a clear, ownership-focused approach that reflects how incidents actually unfold in practice.

Jake Perryman is the founder of Active Mitigation Solutions, a physical security and emergency management consulting firm serving schools, healthcare facilities, municipalities, and private businesses. He works at the intersection of policy and practice, helping organizations move beyond compliance toward genuine operational capability.

Jake brings a practitioner's perspective shaped by his service in the United States Air Force as a member of the Security Forces. While with the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), he mentored Site Security Plan development and audited compliance across the security, cyber, and emergency management spaces. Most organizations are compliant. The harder question is how many are capable.
